Re: AGIA Public Comments
Statistical Analysis

After excluding duplicates and multiple comments from single individuals, approximately 270 individuals and institutions filed timely comments in the public comment period. Below are some of the statistics.

35% had questions, comments or concerns but no position on the license award
7.5% supported awarding the license to TransCanada
29% opposed awarding the license to TransCanada
28.5% supported either AGPA, All Alaska line, or LNG line
10% supported a ConocoPhillips line
50%* either opposed TransCanada or supported AGPA/LNG or ConocoPhillips

*Some of the parties opposed TransCanada and supported either the AGPA/LNG line or the ConocoPhillips proposal. When the duplication was deleted approximately 50% of the comments either opposed the TransCanada proposal outright or supported another proposal instead.

An additional 20 individuals and institutions filed comments after the comment period closed. Of those comments approximately 50% either opposed awarding the TransCanada license or supported AGPA/LNG.
